

This event requires a pool of 15-18 players from your own area (we may have to team up with Berwick-Upon-Tweed League to gain the required numbers). Will be played in round robin groups of 4 or 5 teams. Played in the North Berwick area at agreed venues throughout April and May. Semi Finals and Final played in the Quarterdeck Bar. Prize money and trophies for Semi Finalists, Runner-Up and Champion. (A three year Seeding system for this event only is in progress, takes effect for the 2006 event). I am looking into the possibility at having another trophy to coincide with main event for Non Qualifiers of group stages.</p> <p><u>North Berwick And District Pool League Competition</u> It has been suggested as a league we should try to organise a weekend event in our area with the backing of the S.P.A. For this to take place we would require a venue which could accommodate 8 tables minimum (THE BIGGER THE VENUE MEANS MORE TABLE SPACE ALLOWING A LARGER ENTRY!!!!!!). We would also have to look into accommodation in the area of suggested venue for players travelling from other areas.
