7	<p><u>Scottish Pool Association</u></p> <p>BC provided a report as follows: -</p> <p><u>British Open Singles & Scottish Pairs</u></p> <p>There has been an extension to the closing date for the British Open Singles and the Scottish Pairs.</p> <p>Anyone interested in playing in either or both of these events should submit their name to Brad Chisholm by 01-04-04 (money required for 01-05-04) entry fee for British Open is £10 per player, and Scottish Pairs £5 per player (qualifiers may have to join up with Berwick League).</p> <p><u>National Team Event (County)</u></p> <p>This event is played in conjunction with the Scottish Pairs Finals.</p> <p>Also in conjunction with these events are The 5 Man Team Event, Mixed Doubles and Doubles Flyers. PLEASE NOTE THAT PLAYERS CANNOT PLAY IN BOTH 5 MAN TEAM & COUNTY!!!</p> <p>County teams can be made up from players from our own domestic league (NBDPL) or with other S.P.A affiliated leagues within our county (E.Loathian).</p> <p>No Internationalists allowed to play county events.</p> <p>No professionals allowed to play in the 5 man team event.</p> <p>Entry money for the above events required 01-10-04</p> <p>County= £30 per players accommodation and £150 per team</p> <p>5 man team =£30 per players accommodation and £50 per team. (refer to previous notes)</p> <p><u>Scottish Singles</u></p> <p>All entries for this event close on 01-05-04.</p> <p>Anyone who qualifies for the finals of this event will be required to stay at the venue (rooms are pre-booked) cost of this is £32 per player.</p>

	<p><u>Chisholm Shield</u></p> <p>This event closes 31-03-04 £10 entry Round robin stages of 3-4 matches at 3 frames per match. Qualifiers go forward to knockout stages, Non Qualifiers will then play for a separate trophy (new for this years event) Match format will lengthen in the main event as tournament progresses.</p> <p>For non qualifiers all remaining matches will be played on a best of three frames format.</p> <p>Contact B. Chisholm, D Kerr or the Quarterdeck Bar regarding entry (Flyers for this competition were issued to team Captains at the last meeting).</p> <p><u>New Scottish League Rules</u></p> <p>It was pointed out to all members that there is/will be changes to our playing rules for season 2004-2005. (Awaiting confirmation on which rules have been changed).</p> <p>Let's hope they put a little more thought into this matter than they did last year!</p> <p><u>Referee Examinations</u></p> <p>For anyone interested there will be referee examinations at the S.P.A May meeting. Cost is £10 and £5 if you have to re-sit the exam. (obviously the new rules will be required) For further information contact either Brad Chisholm 07989 199 003 or Kenny Robertson 01383 414 616.</p> <p><u>Banishment of Players and teams</u></p> <p>It was brought to the committee's attention that at the Pettycure Bay venue there had been an argument ensuing into hands being raised between two Dunfermline players. As we all know this sort of behaviour will not be tolerated at any level of the game. To try and combat this there has been a new rule brought in taking effect immediately.</p> <p>Any player(s) causing disruption at any S.P.A. event will be banned with the right to appeal for a maximum of two years, if the said player(s) team causes any further disruptions within a two year period from original complaint then this will result in that team being banned for a two year period. (Simple solution to this is not to select prospective trouble makers for these events)</p> <p>Domestic leagues can also approach the S.P.A. committee to have players banned from S.P.A. events when the player(s) in question are banned from their own domestic league, but S.P.A. cannot banish players from their domestic league even though they have been banned from all S.P.A. events. (The reason for this is legal technicalities).</p> <p><u>SPA Liaison Required</u></p> <p>BC confirmed that he requires a volunteer to attend SPA meetings when he is unavailable.
